Frontend programming and website projects

Unless your using a web service or TiddlyWiki, you create all the files of your website. That configuration or pattern of files becomes a standard for creating websites, I call the projects Anchor, Deferment, and Displays.

The code implements the logic for a layout system but has nothing to do with the style of the website. It's the best way I've found to mix HTML, CSS, and JavaScript files together.
